## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard in Year 3 reading and numeracy to 100%;
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in reading to 63%;
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in numeracy to 53%.

- Improve staff capacity through focused professional development;
- Develop and implement a consistent approach to the teaching of reading and comprehension;

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employ a Speech Language Pathologist to provide programs for identified students and provide professional development to teachers and teacher aides;	\$16 000
• Purchase teaching resources to facilitate instruction;	\$26 042
• Employ and train teacher aides to support identified students to improve numeracy and reading based on class data;	\$20 000
• Teaching team release to unpack the curriculum and assessment, analyse data and develop learning plans which respond to student progress;	\$42 600
• Conduct professional development for staff relevant to the literacy and numeracy components of the school's Pedagogical Framework;	\$18 000
• Release teachers and teacher aides to conduct Early Start assessment in Literacy and Numeracy for Prep, Year 1 and Year 2 students.	\$ 6 480
